Deputies Investigating Morning Home Invasion Robbery and Burglary Attempt

This morning at approximately 8:15AM, Leon County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the 100 Block of Elena Dive in reference to a home invasion robbery. The victim reported hearing her dogs barking and observed an unknown suspect entering her residence through an unlocked door. The suspect saw the victim standing at the door, knocked her to the floor and stole her wallet. The suspect then fled the area in an unknown direction. The victim was not injured during this robbery. The suspect is described as a black male, 6'0", brown eyes, black hair wearing a black hoodie and black gloves.

Later in the morning at approximately 11:00AM, Deputies responded to the 200 block of Hemley Loop in reference to an attempted burglary. The victim reported two suspects knocked on her door several times and when she did not answer they attempted to kick open the door. The victim shouted through the door that she was calling 911 and the suspects fled. The victim described suspect #1 as a black male, 5'9", 170lbs, and suspect #2 as black male, 5'7" and 170lbs. The victim observed the suspects flee in an older model, dark grey, SUV (possibly a Chevy Suburban). While Deputies searched the area for these suspects, a burglary of an unoccupied residence was discovered in the 100 block of Ivernia Loop.
