Community Advisory: Special Attention Lakewood Village Neighborhood

Yesterday evening, a concerned parent reported that her 13yoa daughter encountered a suspicious person as she was walking in the Lakewood Village Neighborhood. The child reported that at approximately 5:00PM she walking on Rustic Drive when a male subject asked her if she wanted a ride. The child refused and began walking through a trail towards Autumn Woods Way. When the child emerged from the trail the subject was waiting. The subject asked the child if she was a runaway and if she needed a ride. The child became concerned for her safety and got the attention of a friend who was riding his bicycle in the area. When the subject observed the child had obtained the attention of a friend he drove away. After the subject left the area the child went home and reported this encounter with a stranger to her mother, who contacted the Sheriff's Office.

The suspicious subject is described as a dark skinned black male, 30's, clean shaven, dreads with a medium build. The subject was driving a blue convertible with dark tinted windows with custom tires and rims. The child reported she has seen this same vehicle driving slowly in the neighborhood several times before.

Deputies ask residents of Lakewood Village to report any information they may have of the described subject and/or vehicle.
