Leon County Sheriff's Office Conducting DUI Check Points

The Leon County Sheriff's Office will conduct two DUI Check points on Thursday night, December 04, 2008. These check points are part of the Leon County Sheriff's Office on-going efforts to stop impaired driving in our community. The first check point will be on Geddie Road from 7:00 pm until 9:00 pm. The second check point will be held on Veterans Memorial Highway in Miccosukee from 10:00 pm until 12:00 am.

Sheriff Larry Campbell wants to get the word out that impaired driving is a dangerous and, too often, deadly crime. "Driving after drinking is a choice. Choose to do the right and the safe thing: find alternate transportation, use a designated driver, or don't consume any amount of alcohol if you intend to drive. Deaths due to alcohol-related crashes are preventable, these are not accidents - these are serious crimes with deadly consequences. The Leon County Sheriff's Office will be out in force this holiday season to reduce the number of alcohol-related crashes by arresting impaired drivers and taking them off our streets" said Sheriff Campbell.
