Detectives Searching for Suspect in Theft Case

The Leon County Sheriff's Office is requesting assistance in locating the suspect in a theft case that occurred on December 7, 2010, at 11:40 a.m. Detectives from the Financial Crimes Unit believe a black female entered Astoria Park Elementary School's main office and gained access to a classroom. The suspect then took a teacher's wallet from the classroom. The suspect left the campus in a black Cadillac SUV. Gift cards were purchased with the stolen debit card at Publix on Ocala Road and CVS Pharmacy.

The suspect in this case even made contact with the victim and identified herself as a law enforcement officer with the "Leon County Police Department."
