Cheryl Dunlap Update

Tallahassee- A press conference was held today at the Leon County Sheriff's Office to not only update the community on the progress of the Cheryl Dunlap case, but to request the assistance of everyone with the identification of a possible suspect and vehicle.

The investigation to date has revealed that Ms. Dunlap's ATM card was used at an undisclosed location in Leon County on December 2nd, 3rd and 4th to obtain an undisclosed amount of cash. The suspect, identified via the ATM's video camera, is described as a tall thin man apparently wearing gloves, a hat, and some sort of mask in an obvious attempt to hide his identity. Detectives from the Violent Crimes unit, Wakulla County and FDLE conducted a surveillance of the ATM's location for a week with negative results. Detectives have also received information on a possible vehicle of interest that was reportedly seen near Ms. Dunlap's vehicle where it was abandoned on Crawfordville Highway at approximately 5:00pm to 6:00pm on December 1st. The vehicle is described as a long wheel based extended cab Dodge Ram pick-up truck black in color.
