### **Pursuit of Burglary Suspects**

Tallahassee- Deputies respond to a Burglary of an Occupied Dwelling that resulted in a pursuit.

At approximately 2:30 p.m. today the Leon County Sheriff's Office received a call from a resident on Journeys End Rd. stating that someone had broken into the residence. The victim described the suspects as two black males and also described their vehicle as black in color. The victim remained hidden inside the residence while talking to dispatchers until deputies arrived on the scene.

The suspects left the area prior to the deputy's arrival, however; a neighbor who witnessed the incident followed the suspects until deputies could catch up to them. Deputies as well as a Tallahassee Police officer and an FDLE agent caught up to the vehicle and initiated a traffic stop on Meridian Road. The suspect fled South on Meridian into town. The pursuing officers, recognizing the potential hazard to the general public, terminated the pursuit due to a high volume of traffic in the area.

Deputies later discovered the vehicle at the intersection of Jim Lee rd. and Chocksacka Nene. The vehicle had been involved in a crash and abandoned by the suspects. Deputies on scene discovered several items in the vehicle that had been reported as stolen during the burglary.

The suspect's identities are not known at this time.
