Leon County Sheriff's Office Capture Wanted Murder Suspect

On Monday December 29, 2008, at approximately 12:30PM, Leon County Sheriff's Deputies responded to 1720 Sunbeam Lane in reference to the discovery of the murder of Mileah Lindsey. During the course of this investigation Violent Crime Detectives obtained information and evidence implicating Haywood Henry in this homicide. On Tuesday December 30, 2008, VCU Detectives obtained a 1st Degree Murder warrant for Henry. Henry was also wanted for outstanding warrants of Sexual Battery with a Firearm, Resisting Arrest with Violence, Grand Theft Auto, Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer and Felony Battery.

Today Detectives and SWAT Team members with the Leon County Sheriff's Office continued the search for Henry in the area of western Leon County and Sunbeam Lane. At approximately 6:00PM Detectives received information that Henry was hiding in a residence in the 1700 block of Sunbeam Lane. SWAT Team members searched the residence and found Henry hiding in the refrigerator. Henry was arrested without incident. Henry is charged with the 1st Degree Murder of Lindsey and will be booked into the Leon County Jail.
