Tallahassee Woman Arrested on Outstanding Santa Rosa County Murder Warrant

A Tallahassee woman was arrested on outstanding murder warrants charged with a thirteen year old homicide investigation that occurred in Santa Rosa County, Florida.

Santa Rosa County deputies notified the Leon County Sheriff's Office they had just obtained murder arrest warrants for Kimberly Cannon, 8-24-67, stemming from a the thirteen year investigation. Information developed during the investigation indicated Cannon had recently established residency in Tallahassee after her release from a four year prison sentence at Gadsden County Correctional facility.

Leon and Santa Rosa County deputies staked out Cannon's residence in the 1100 Block of Idlewild Drive. Shortly before 1:00 AM this morning, Cannon arrived at the residence. Shortly thereafter she was taken into custody.

During transport to the Sheriff's Office, Cannon unknowing to the deputy, slipped off her handcuffs. When the deputy opened the cruiser door, Cannon fought with him and attempted to flee. A struggle ensued and during the conflict, Cannon reportedly attempted to take the deputy's gun. Cannon was taken into custody after a Taser was deployed.

Sheriff Larry Campbell said "this is a classic example of basic law enforcement. Deputies working together using tried and true tactics took a very dangerous person off the streets and out of our community".
