Catfish Pad Restaurant Robbed

Last night, Wednesday May 28, 2008, at approximately 9:15p.m. two unknown male subjects robbed the Catfish Pad Restaurant located at 4229 West Pensacola Street. As employees were leaving the closed restaurant, two black males dressed in all black emerged from some near by bushes and demand all of their money. The victims reported, the suspects acted as if they were armed with guns, but they did not see any. After taking money from the restaurant, they also stole money and personal items from the victims. After the robbery the suspects left the area, last seen running to the rear of the restaurant.

Suspect One Description: Black Male, Dark Complexion, Early 20's, 5'0", 145lbs, wearing all black.

Suspect Two Descriptions: Black Male, Dark Complexion, Early 20's, 5'5", 145lbs, wearing all black.

Vehicle of Interest: Late 1980's or early 1990's white Oldsmobile Delta 88. This vehicle was seen leaving the area immediately after the robbery at a high rate of speed.
