### Commercial Burglaries from Weekend Cleared

On 05-29-2010, the CVS Pharmacy located at 5810 North Monroe Street was burglarized. During this incident, the front doors were smashed in by a white male in a white Ford truck. Several cartons of cigarettes were stolen. On 05-30-2010, the Shell Station at 1500 Bannerman Road was burglarized in a similar manner. Lottery tickets and cigarettes were stolen during this incident. The same white male from the CVS drove a Dodge truck to damage the front doors of the Shell Station.

William Powell, 21, was arrested by the Tallahassee Police Department and charged in connection with a series of commercial burglaries that took place over the holiday weekend. Powell was also suspect in cases being investigated by LCSO and the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office. When Powell was arrested by TPD, investigators contacted the Property Crimes Unit.

Powell was interviewed in reference to the LCSO cases and detectives determined he was responsible for the burglaries at the CVS and Shell Station.

This investigation is ongoing and additional charges are likely. Powell remains in the Leon County Jail.
