Fatal Crash Investigation Continues

The Leon County Sheriff's Office responded to a single car crash on Friday, January 28, 2011 near the intersection of Miccosukee Road and Miles Johnson Road. When deputies arrived, they found the vehicle fully engulfed. Passersby were able to pull two people from the wreckage, however two others died as a result of the crash.

Leon County Sheriff's Office Traffic Homicide Investigators have determined that the Ford Crown Victoria was travelling east on Miccosukee Road near the intersection of Miles Johnson when it left the roadway and hit a tree on the shoulder of the road. After striking the tree, the vehicle flipped and rolled before coming to rest on its roof. The vehicle then caught fire and burned.

Autopsies were performed Saturday, January 29, 2011 and preliminary results were consistent with the initial findings from the scene. The two people that died in the crash have not been positively identified as of this time and the two survivors remain hospitalized. Antoine Young, 27, was listed in critical condition while Yvette Marshall, 43, suffered non-life threatening injuries.

The investigation into the circumstances surrounding this crash remains active and ongoing.
