Fatal Stabbing Investigation Ends with Grand Jury Presentation

On Wednesday, July 21, 2010 the Leon County Sheriff's Office closed the investigation into the death of Timothy J. Cobb.

On Saturday morning, October 24, 2009, at 7:40AM Leon County Sheriff's Deputies were called to 9205 Miccosukee Road in reference to a subject who had been stabbed. When Deputies arrived they discovered Timothy J. Cobb, 31, inside the residence. CPR was administered by Deputies and Cobb was transported to a local hospital for treatment where he died a short time later. Violent Crimes and Crime Scene Detectives investigated the death. The investigation revealed that Cobb was the former boyfriend of Kathryn Hall, 47, who was inside the residence with Anthony Mack, 40. Cobb was upset because Mack was at the residence and demanded to be let inside. Fearing a fight would take place, Hall and Mack refused to allow Cobb inside the residence. Cobb then broke into the residence by forcing the rear door open and attacked Mack. During the attack, Mack was able to arm himself with a kitchen knife and stab Cobb several times. An autopsy confirmed that Cobb died as a result of multiple stab wounds.

Based on the results of the autopsy, the forensic investigation at the scene, and interviews with Hall and Mack, the investigation was forwarded to the State Attorney's Office for review. The case was presented to the Leon County Grand Jury this morning. The Grand Jury returned a "no true bill" after reviewing the evidence in the case.
