### Man Arrested for Meth Lab

On Monday, June 07, 2010 the Leon County Sheriff's Office received information that led them to a clandestine methamphetamine laboratory in western Leon County. A concerned citizen provided information which led to Vice Unit detectives obtaining a search warrant for the residence located at 2542 Rainey Allen Road in the Fort Braden community. Detectives secured the residence and discovered the remnants of the manufacturing process for methamphetamine. Detectives seized hot plates, camping fuel, cold pills and other chemicals which are used in the manufacturing process.

Detectives interviewed and arrested Tony Ansley, 44, for manufacturing Methamphetamine. Ansley was transported to the Leon County Jail.

The manufacturing process for methamphetamine is extremely dangerous. Earlier in the year, a methamphetamine lab exploded on Veterans Memorial Highway in the Miccosukee community. Unusual chemical odors are only one factor that could indicate the presence of a methamphetamine lab. The Leon County Sheriff's Office encourages citizens to report any suspicious activity.
