Shooting Suspect Arrested for Attempted 1st Degree Murder

On Monday June 2, 2008, at approximately 12:30 p.m. Deputy Craig Henry was flagged down at Franklin Blvd and Tennessee St. by a male subject that had been shot in the right shoulder. At the time the victim reported he was standing on an unknown street in the area of Lake Bradford Rd. when he was shot. A passer-by discovered the victim in the 900 Block of Gamble St. and was transporting him to the hospital when they flagged down Deputy Henry. After the victim was treated for his injury, Violent Crimes Detective Brian Bishop was able to learn more details about the shooting.

The victim reported he was at 1919 Holton Street when he was shot by Greg Turner in a dispute over money. After the argument, Turner struck the victim on the left side of his head with a small silver handgun. As the victim leaned over from the force of the blow, Turner shot him in the right shoulder. The victim did not realize he was shot at the time and began to walk away, as Tuner fired another shot into the air. The victim then realized he was bleeding and that he had been shot. An acquaintance of the victim drove up moments later and saw he was bleeding, then drove him to the hospital.

This morning members of the North Florida Violent Fugitive Task Force located and arrested Turner at a residence in the 500 block of Famcee Street. Turner was taken into custody without incident.
