Update: Detectives Arrest Stanley Savary, Jr. for Homicide

On Saturday, February 5, 2011 detectives with the Leon County Sheriff's Office arrested and charged Stanley Savary, Jr, 45, in connection with the murder of 60 year old Nina Savary and the attempted murder of 72 year old Stanley Savary, Sr. Stanley Savary, Jr. was released from Tallahassee Memorial Hospital following treatment for a gunshot wound to the chest.

At approximately 8:45 p.m. on January 12, 2011, the Leon County Sheriff's Office responded to a residence in the 10,000 block of Rose Road in reference to a shooting. Upon their arrival, deputies discovered three persons with gunshot wounds, one of them, Nina Savary, was dead.

Detectives from the Crime Scene and Violent Crimes Units responded to the scene and launched an investigation into the chain of events surrounding the shooting. Detectives confirmed that Nina Savary died on the scene. Nina's husband, Stanley Savary, Sr. was initially treated at Tallahassee Memorial Hospital for gunshot wounds to the neck and hand. He remains in an extended treatment facility.

Detectives believe Stanley Savary, Jr. shot Nina Savary in the head with a handgun, killing her. He then shot his father through the hand and neck, seriously injuring Stanley Savary, Sr. Jeffrey Savary, 35, attempted to subdue his brother and was able to wrestle the handgun away from him. During the struggle, Stanley Savary, Jr. was shot in the chest.
