Update: LCSO Locates Person of Interest in Shooting

Leon County Sheriff's Office Violent Crimes Detectives have located and interviewed Maurice Shipman in reference to the shooting incident that took place this afternoon on Lost Pine Drive. The investigation is continuing. Another man, Kevion Mason, remains in Tallahassee Memorial Hospital recovering from a gunshot wound. Mason's condition is listed as stable.

On Friday, July 16, 2010 the Leon County Sheriff's office responded to Lost Pine Drive in reference to a report of two suspicious men in the area. A caller advised one of the men was armed with a gun. Minutes later, deputies received another call reporting that a car had crashed into a fence at 4471 Lost Pine Drive and left the scene. Next, deputies learned that a man had shown up at Tallahassee Memorial Hospital with a gunshot wound to his left arm. Violent Crimes Detectives and Crime Scene Detectives responded to the scenes at the hospital and on Lost Pine Drive in order to conduct follow up interviews, obtain witness statements and collect physical evidence.
