Student Arrested for Carrying Weapon on Campus

Tallahassee- A sixteen year old Leon High School student was arrested Tuesday after School Resource Deputy locates concealed weapon in his pocket.

During school on Tuesday, Leon High School officials brought Willie Massey to the school administrative office suspecting he was possessing contraband. School officials attempted to search Massey with resistance. They then summonsed SRD Deputy Milliken.

According to reports Deputy Milliken witnessed what appeared to be the handle of a weapon in Massey's front pocket. Deputy Milliken attempted to retrieve the object and a struggle ensued. Massey was quickly taken into custody without further incident. A ten and one half inch (10 ½) fillet knife was recovered from Massey's front pocket.

Massey was arrested and charged with Carrying a Weapon on School Grounds, Carrying a Concealed Weapon, and Resisting Arrest without Violence. He was taken to JAC.

Sgt. Curtis Parker, SRD Supervisor said "this incident could have quickly escalated into a dangerous situation for all involved. Deputy Milliken's quick response enabled him to control the situation".
