AGENCY DECISION

The Leon County Sheriff's Office has determined it is our best interest to reject all responses received for RFP 20231015, Security Camera Maintenance and Support, and that this procurement be re-solicited.

Per Section 119.071(1), (b), 3, Florida Statutes (F.S.), if a government agency rejects all bids in response to a competitive solicitation and the government agency concurrently provides notice of its intent to reissue the competitive solicitation, the rejected bids remain exempt from Section 119.07(1), F.S. and Section 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution, until such time as the government agency, provides notice of an intended decision concerning the reissued competitive solicitation or until the government agency withdraws the reissued competitive solicitation, or 12 months after the initial government agency notice rejecting all bids.

Per Section 120.57(3), F.S., a Notice of Intent to Protest or a Formal Written Protest must be filed with the LCSO Purchasing Department within the timeframes established in law. Filings may be made physically at 3333 West Pensacola Street, Suite 130, Tallahassee, FL 32304, or via email to kirklandka@leoncountyfl.gov. Protests must comply with Rules 28-110.003 and 28-110.004, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). Filings received on weekends, County holidays, or after 5:00 p.m. will be filed the next business day. Failure to file a protest within the time prescribed in Section 120.57(3), F.S., or failure to post the bond or other security required by law within the time allowed for filing a bond shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under Chapter 120, F.S.
