LCSO Investigation Leads to Stolen Firearms and Drugs

On Friday, January 5th, as part of an ongoing narcotics investigation, the Leon County Sheriff's Office's Vice and Narcotics Unit, assisted by the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas program (HIDTA), executed a search warrant at a residence in the area of San Mateo Court and Hartsfield Road in northwest Leon County.

During the search, detectives found ballistic body armor and several weapons, including one firearm reported stolen from Taylor County. Additionally, they discovered drugs packaged for sale: approximately 7.4 grams of powder cocaine, 3.15 grams of crack cocaine, and 6.58 grams of Alpha-PVP. Several items of drug paraphernalia were also seized, such as a fake Mountain Dew bottle used to conceal drugs.

The warrant resulted in the arrest of 41-year-old Brynn Sermon, who faces various charges related to the illegal sale of narcotics, possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, grand theft of a firearm, among others.
