LCSO Makes Arrests in Drive-by Shooting

On Saturday, September 9th, around 9:30 p.m., Leon County Sheriff's Office deputies responded to a residence in the 2700 block of Cathedral Drive in reference to a drive-by shooting threat. Before deputies arrived, the Consolidated Dispatch Agency (CDA) received several additional calls from the same area in reference to a shooting in progress.

Shortly after, deputies arrived on the scene and found a residence riddled with bullets and spent shell casings around the property's perimeter. Two individuals reported injuries that required no medical attention.

Through investigative means, detectives identified the shooting suspect as 20-year-old Omri Turner and the driver of the vehicle involved as 18-year-old Shi'Liyah Randall.

Both suspects have been located and arrested. They are now detained at the Leon County Detention Facility, facing several charges related to this incident and additional charges are pending.

This is an active and ongoing investigation. As part of its Cease Fire initiative, LCSO, in collaboration with Big Bend Crime Stoppers, will offer a monetary reward leading to the arrest of an individual illegally possessing a firearm. Tipsters can remain anonymous and receive a \$1,000 reward. To report a tip, residents should call 850-574-TIPS. Callers will be given a code that can be checked for updates on the case. If an arrest is made, a pick-up code will be sent with the location where the reward may be collected. Tipsters must use the anonymous system to receive the reward.
