LCSO Receives Nearly \$250,000 Federal Grant for De-escalation Strategies Research

The Leon County Sheriff's Office (LCSO) has been awarded a grant of \$249,950 as part of the Fiscal Year 2023/2024 Community Policing Development - Law Enforcement Agency De-Escalation Grants. The grant approval was made by the Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) on behalf of U.S. Attorney General Merrick B. Garland. This grant will enable LCSO to further its commitment to enhancing community policing by researching and implementing effective de-escalation strategies.
