The Leon County Sheriff's Office and the Leon County Deputies Chapter of the Florida Police Benevolent Association are pleased to announce a bargaining agreement, beneficial to Leon County Sheriff's Office deputies, as well as the agency.

As part of the new contract, a competitive salary plan is established with a new minimum of \$50,000 for all sworn members of the agency.
