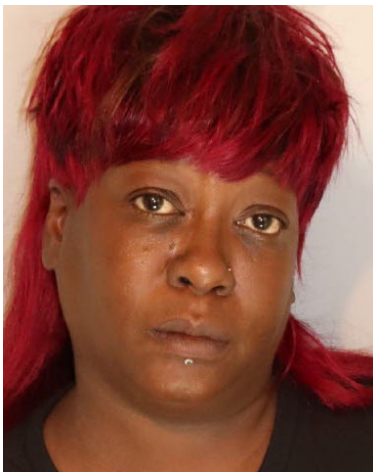
LCSO Deputies Collaborate to Arrest Suspect on 72 Felony Warrants

On the evening of Friday, September 29th, Leon County Sheriff's Office deputies apprehended 46-year-old Katrice James in connection with an extensive list of felony warrants issued against her. These warrants, filed by the Jackson County Sheriff's Office, accused her of 72 counts of charges related to Unlawful Compensation or Reward for Official Behavior.

James was employed as a correctional officer with the Florida Department of Corrections.

"Correctional officers must abide by and adhere to the same laws they take an oath to uphold and enforce," said Florida Department of Corrections Secretary Ricky Dixon. "We appreciate the swift action of our law enforcement partners and will work with them to thoroughly investigate the incident. These events serve as a reminder that no one is above the law."

James was arrested and transported to the Leon County Detention Facility.
