LCSO Proactive Patrols Net Drug Arrest

On Monday, July 18, the Leon County Sheriff's Office Narcotics Unit conducted proactive operations in the area of Mahan Drive and Capital Circle, when detectives observed an individual wanted on a previous drug warrant.

41-year-old Lloyd Seay was taken into custody. Seay was found to be in possession of more than 15 grams of methamphetamine, which constitutes Drug Trafficking. Seay was also in possession of several other items of drug paraphernalia, including a digital scale and small plastic baggies.

Seay was booked into the Leon County Detention Facility and faces additional charges.

This is an ongoing investigation. These proactive measures illustrate the commitment of LCSO to combat crime in our communities and continue to make Leon County a safer place to live, work, and play.
