LCSO Investigation Leads to Stolen Gun and Drugs

On Tuesday, June 20th, as part of an ongoing narcotics investigation, the Leon County Sheriff's Office's Vice and Narcotics Unit, assisted by members from the North Star Multijurisdictional Task Force and the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas program (HIDTA), executed a search warrant at a residence in the 4300 block of Lost Pine Drive, in southern Leon County.

During the search, detectives recovered the following weapons and drugs, which lead to the arrest of 43-year-old Glenn Dilworth:

- Approx. 6.4 grams of Crack Cocaine
- Beretta .25 handgun
- Cobra .380 (Reported stolen out of Columbus, GA)
- Marijuana

Dilworth is facing several charges related to the sales of illegal narcotics, possession of a firearm by a convicted firearm, grand theft of a firearm, among others.

This is an active and ongoing investigation. The Leon County Sheriff's Office is committed to taking guns used illegally and dangerous drugs off the streets in Tallahassee and Leon County, for the safety of the citizens.
