Traffic Stop Leads to Fentanyl and Cocaine Arrest

On Saturday, June 4, around 8:25 p.m., a Leon County Sheriff's deputy observed a habitual traffic offender in the driver seat of a vehicle at a convenience store in the 6600 block of Thomasville Road. The deputy ran a driver license check and confirmed the driver, identified as 31-year-old Maxwell Collins, was not permitted to drive, due to a suspended driver license.

After initiating a traffic stop, the deputy confirmed Collin's identity and placed him under arrest.

The deputy also detected the odor of marijuana coming from inside the vehicle. A search of the vehicle uncovered multiple controlled substances and various articles of drug paraphernalia that included the following:

- 6.1 grams of Fentanyl
- 2.8 grams of Cocaine
- 28.5 grams of Methamphetamines
- 35.5 milliliters of THC Oil
- 30 Suboxone Pills
- 1.6 pounds of Marijuana
- Scale and Grinder

Collins was arrested and transported to the Leon County Detention Facility. He is booked on the following charges:
