Deputies Arrest Convicted Felon with Stolen Shotgun

On June 1, 2019, Leon County Sheriff's Office deputies responded to the 4800 block of Avery Circle in reference to a report Travis Reddick pointed a shotgun at someone.

When deputies arrived on scene, the victim was not there and could not be contacted. 32-year-old Reddick was still on scene. Deputies spoke with Reddick and located a shotgun nearby. Reddick already had an outstanding warrant for his arrest and admitted he had possessed the shotgun.

The shotgun had been reported stolen to the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office.

Reddick is a convicted felon. He was arrested and taken to the Leon County Detention Facility.
