Deputies Arrest Man with Stolen Gun on School Campus After Hours

Just before midnight last night, a Leon County Sheriff's Office deputy, working an off duty detail at Godby High School, found 22 year old Lamont Christmas, Jr., trespassing on school property.

Deputies found Christmas walking between two buildings and stopped him. Christmas was carrying a backpack. Inside the backpack, deputies located a .45 caliber firearm, which had been reported stolen to the Tallahassee Police Department in 2017. They also found loose .45 caliber ammunition and drug paraphernalia in the bag.

Christmas was on probation for a burglary from 2015 and is a convicted felon. He was booked into the Leon County Detention Facility early this morning.

No students were at the school at the time of the incident.
