LCSO Arrests Sexual Predator after Community Complaints

The Leon County Sheriff's Office arrested 50 year old Anthony Caesar Wednesday, September 5, after investigating complaints from a neighborhood homeowner's association.

LCSO was told Caesar had approached a mother and her 10 year old child at Lafayette Park and offered to give free tennis lessons to her and her minor children. She did meet Caesar a few days later for the lessons.

Detectives were told Caesar was at Lafayette Park playing tennis yesterday afternoon and went to talk with him. Caesar was found at the tennis courts less than 300 feet from children attending an after school program in the park. There were also minors sitting on a park bench a few feet from the tennis court.

Caesar met with detectives at the Sheriff's Office and was interviewed. During the interview Caesar admitted to having text communication with another 16 year old female.

Caesar was taken to the Leon County Detention Facility after the interview.

Caesar's sexual predator status stem from charges in Duval County in 1997.
