LCSO Arrests Trio in Fraudulent Return Scam

On Tuesday December 11, 2018, Leon County Patrol deputies responded to the Walmart, located on Lagniappe Way, in reference to a theft of items. Walmart employees saw three black males take three home arcade games, totaling \$897, without paying and then leave the store.

The suspects first purchased the items with cash and loaded them into a vehicle in the parking lot. One of the suspects then went back into the store, selected three of the exact same items and left the store without paying for them. The suspect used the receipt from the previous transaction as proof he had purchased the items.

The next day, Walmart employees called deputies back to the same store, after seeing the suspects return. They purchased a television and two gaming systems with cash. When they left the store this time, staff had been alerted to mark the receipt so it could not be reused. One of the suspects then took the items back into the store to return them for cash.

All three suspects; 56 year old John Mobley, Sr., 37 year old Reginald Dugger, Jr., and 34 year old Trent Tucker, were arrested by LCSO detectives at the store and transported to the Leon County Detention Facility.
