LCSO Arrests Two in Burglary in Progress

Yesterday, the Consolidated Dispatch Agency received a call about a burglary in progress in the 1300 block of Ocala Road. While on proactive patrol in the area, the Leon County Sheriff's Office SPIDER Unit responded to the burglary and saw the suspect vehicle as it was leaving the scene.

Two of the suspects involved, 21 year old Antonio Lee and 27 year old James Bouie, ran from the scene of the burglary. Both were taken into custody after a brief foot chase.

The LCSO helicopter responded to the area and located the suspect vehicle abandoned not far from the scene of the burglary. Items stolen in the burglary were also located with the vehicle.
