LCSO Detectives Arrest Man in Saturday Homicide

On August 14, 2021, shortly after 1 p.m., the Leon County Sheriff's Office received a call for service in reference to an injured person at a residence in the 2900 block of Cathedral Drive in southwest Leon County. Deputies responded to the residence and located a victim suffering from life-threatening injuries. The injuries would prove to be fatal, and the victim was pronounced deceased on scene. LCSO Violent Crimes and Crime Scene units responded to the scene and assumed the investigation.

During the investigation, detectives learned the victim and the suspect, 36-year-old Christopher Harvey, were co-habitants at the Cathedral Drive residence and had been arguing in the early hours of the day before deputies were called to the address. Further in the investigation, detectives would determine the victim's fatal injuries were caused by the actions of Harvey.

In accordance with Florida's Marsy's law, the victim's identification and personal information is being withheld.

Harvey was arrested and transported to the Leon County Detention Facility.

Additional charges are possible as this investigation remains active.
