LCSO Detectives Make Arrest in Burglary Case

On 06/18/18, deputies from the Leon County Sheriff's Office took a report of a burglary to a carport and attempted burglary to two vehicles in the 3600 block of Westmoreland Drive.

The home owner captured video of the suspect and turned it over to deputies.

On 06/19/18, the same homeowner saw, on video, the same suspect had come back again in an attempt to get into his vehicles. The vehicles were not entered because both were locked.

Another resident in the same area also found the suspect around his residence on his home security system.

Through investigative means, the suspect, **Santeze Thompson**, was identified by LCSO detectives assigned to the Leon County Sheriff's Office/Tallahassee Police Department Joint Property Crimes Task Force. Thompson lives in close proximity to the victims.

Today, Thompson was interviewed by detectives at the Leon County Sheriff's Office and subsequently arrested and taken to the Leon County Detention Facility.
