LCSO S.P.I.D.E.R. Unit Arrests Two in Stolen Vehicle Investigation

On March 17, 2020, the LCSO S.P.I.D.E.R. (Special Projects Investigations Detection Enforcement Response) Unit conducted directed patrol in the area of Alabama Street and Colorado Street. Deputies observed a stolen orange Jeep being driven by a black male wearing a light-colored hoodie and black pants, later identified as 18-year-old Anthony Swatts. After the stolen vehicle left the area, LCSO Aviation Unit assisted and located the vehicle in the 800 block of Wadsworth Street with three subjects walking away. A short distance from the vehicle, deputies made contact three black males walking in the area, one being Swatts, who was positively identified as the driver observed earlier and the others being 18-year-old Nyzik Page and 18-year-old Tyrone Powell. Page initially gave deputies a false name, however after obtaining his proper identification he was found to have an active warrant for Failure to Appear for Grand Theft Motor Vehicle and currently on probation.

Two other stolen vehicles were located in the area around the incident. A set of keys to a Volvo were located in the back seat of the recovered Jeep, which are believed to be the keys for a white Volvo that was subsequently recovered on Charlotte Street.

After investigating, deputies released Powell on scene.

Swatts and Page were arrested and transported to the Leon County Detention Facility.
