S.P.I.D.E.R. Unit Seizes Meth on Traffic Stop

Yesterday, the Leon County Sheriff's Office SPIDER Unit arrested Karla Sinaloa 20, and Christopher Hamlin 34, on multiple drug charges.

Due to recent burglaries members of the SPIDER Unit were conducting a directive patrol in the area of Apalachee Parkway. During this operation deputies stopped a vehicle driven by Hamlin. It was determined Hamlin did not have a valid driver's license and passenger, Sinaloa, had several outstanding warrants for her arrest. Both subjects were taken into custody without incident. During the subsequent search of the vehicle deputies located 31 grams of Methamphetamine, 2 Hydromorphone pills, approximately stolen 12 credit cards.

Both Sinaloa and Hamlin were arrested and transported to the Leon County Detention Facility without incident.
