Traffic Stop Leads to Illegally Possessed Firearm Off the Streets

Yesterday afternoon, deputies made contact with 28-year-old Curtis Miller during a routine traffic stop for a seatbelt violation. Miller's Florida driver's license was determined to have multiple suspensions. When Miller stepped out of the vehicle, suspected crack cocaine was observed in the driver's seat. A search of the vehicle was conducted and a fully loaded .380 Taurus was located under the driver's seat and .380 ammunition was located in a backpack on the backseat of the vehicle. Miller was charged accordingly and transported to the Leon County Detention Facility.
